



Quality Control Technician

Job Description:

The Quality Control Technician will be responsible for performing QC inspections and testing manufactured products and supplies, in-process materials, incoming materials testing, and finished products. Additionally, record keeping, scientific analysis, and teamwork will be essential to this role. The QC technician will be responsible for following applicable SOPs and cGMP principles and should be aware of ISO and FDA requirements. This position will report to the Quality Control Supervisor.

Responsibilities:

- Performs analytical quality control testing on raw materials, in process chemicals, and finished products including but not limited to:
 - Total Solids Analysis
 - Viscosity Testing
 - Colorimeter Verification
 - pH
 - FTIR
 - UV-Vis
 - Microbial Analysis
- Performs quality control inspections and analytical testing on incoming materials prior to acceptance into chemical inventory by completing Purchased Materials Inspection Records (PMIRs).
- Document accurate and complete primary data on product Batch Records during analysis using QA technique ALCOA.
- Support Environmental Monitoring for clean room environments, and work within Class 6 Cleanrooms as needed.
- Follows all safety precautions while working within laboratory environments.
- Report product and raw material abnormalities using the CAPA's and NCP's processes. Aid in investigations related to these findings.
- Any other duties or responsibilities necessary as directed.

Secondary Responsibilities:

- Maintain the Quality Control lab and work areas in a clean, safe, and organized manner.
- Manage supply inventory for test materials.
- Identify new test procedure and equipment opportunities.
- Write and edit SOP's as needed.



Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in a Science related field required.
- One year of laboratory experience or training is preferred.
- Demonstrated ability to work with a team to complete goals.
- Advanced written and oral communication skills preferred.
- Equivalent training and experience may be considered to meet the above requirements.

Required Competencies:

- Ability to lift up to 40 lbs.
- Excellent math skills to adequately perform and interpret calculations and test parameters.
- Ability to evaluate and interpret scientific data.
- Working knowledge of Microsoft Office.
- Must be a flexible team player capable of working in a deadline dictated environment.
